Stone Base Grading and Asphalt Base Paving

Dear Resident:

The Contractor will begin placing and grading the stone base and paving the asphalt base pavement on Campbell on Tuesday, September 12. The contractor anticipates this phase of work will take approximately 3-4 days, with a tentative schedule as follows:

On TUESDAY 9/12 the contractor is scheduled to rough grade the stone base. Additional stone material will be delivered, placed and graded.

On WEDNESDAY 9/13 the contractor is scheduled to fine grade the stone base. Driveway ramps will be removed on the south side during this phase. We recommend that you remove any vehicles you will need to use during this period.

On THURSDAY 9/14 the contractor is scheduled to pave the asphalt base pavement.

All south side driveways will be accessible once the paving is complete. North side driveways will be opened once the concrete strength test results are acceptable for vehicle use.

All work is weather dependent and unknown utilities may cause delays.

During working hours (Weekdays, 7:00am to 6:00pm), please do not park on Campbell between Center and River. Please park your vehicles on alternate side streets (Center, Cora, White, Henry) or outside the work zone limits (on Campbell west of Center).

Whenever possible, please limit your trips through the work zone during working hours.
